Jan. 7 - Arrivals, Welcome, and Check-in

Depending on your arrival time, our team will take you around to take your bearings in the city and help you settle in the hotel.

DAY 1 (Jan. 8) - The Tonle Sap Lake & Floating Villages: together we will explore the largest freshwater lake in SE Asia and the communities that live there on floating dwellings on a private boat with lunch served onboard. This adventure will be followed by time in the city and Khmer fine dining in the evening.

DAY 2 (Jan. 9) - Kulen Mountain, Birthplace of Angkor: on our second day, we will discover the sacred location where the Khmer Empire was proclaimed. The site is a mountain covered in dense jungle with a waterfall, unique carvings in its riverbeds, and a pagoda. On our way back we will visit the Landmine Museum.

DAY 3 (Jan. 10) - Community First Village Aquaponics, Meeting Families & School Visit: our team will welcome you in the heart of rural Cambodia, where the organization works with families on aquaponics to promote food security and safety. You will get to learn about and interact with this amazing innovation.

DAY 4 (Jan. 11) - Temple Visits: the entire day will be spent in the archeological park of Angkor and we will be exploring Cambodia's most well-known landmarks such as Angkor Wat and the Bayon Temple. Lunch will be had in the park and the day will be followed by an evening in the town.

DAY 5 (Jan. 12) - Archeological Secrets & Meeting the Artisans: on the second day of our archeological exploration, we will take you to see the lesser known Temples that not many people get to see. This will be followed by visits to an artisan workshop to learn about the local arts and craft and some shopping.

DAY 6 (Jan. 13) - Driving to Phnom Penh: in the morning, we will board our luxury van for a road trip through Cambodia. This will be a great opportunity to really experience all of Cambodia, while making spontaneous stops to meet with the people and explore unique, off-the-beaten-track sites.

DAY 7 (Jan. 14) Phnom Penh Historical & Cultural Tours: upon arrival in the Capital, you will be given unlimited access to the city's major museums. On that day, we will also explore the troubled past of Cambodia and study the impact of the Khmer Rouge rule and meet its survivors.

DAY 8 (Jan. 15) Urban Aquaponics & More: on our last day together, we will take you to the Community First Aquaponic showroom to further explore our work and its impact. In the afternoon, we will visit additional cultural sites and those with evening flights that day will prepare their departures.

DAY 9 (Jan. 16) Cambodia Riviera & Project Development: as an option, we will take you to coastal Cambodia to visit the land for future projects in Kampot Province, an area with great potential for economic and real estate development in one of Asia's fastest-growing economies (add'I fee of \$350, return to Phnom Penh on Jan. 17).
